**Title:** Ordinance #2019-25, an Ordinance Amending the Municipal Code to Permit Serving of Alcohol at Public Events Held on Certain City Properties.

**Suggested Motion:** I move to adopt Ordinance #2019-25, “An Ordinance amending the municipal code to permit serving of alcohol at public events held on certain city properties.

**Background/Summary:**

This Ordinance will update the serving, sale, and consumption of alcohol on certain City properties. These changes include the list of parks where alcohol will be permitted under the ordinance for permitted events by adding Lions Park. It also updates the approval process for permits in the parks to allow for the administrative approval.

It will allow for the use of city facilities for private events, like weddings, where alcohol will be permitted.

The Ordinance updates City facilities where alcohol will be permitted to any City facilities so long as approved by City Council. The MARC and MRAC will still be approved by staff.

It will also allow for City employees, who have been certified by the State of Utah, to participate in the identification checks and alcohol sales and service.
