Background/Summary:

At our request, the City’s on-call consultant, Civil Science Inc., has submitted a task order for design of the Kane Creek Blvd Reconstruction project. The project is the reconstruction of Kane Creek Boulevard from 500 West to US-191. The reconstruction will replace the aging chip and crack sealed pavement, improve storm drainage, and replace old sewer and water lines. The project will also improve the comfort and safety of active transportation by bringing the sidewalks back into ADA compliance, implementing green infrastructure, and adding rectangular rapid flash beacons (RRFBs) to increase visibility of pedestrians crossing Kane Creek Blvd.

The conceptual engineer’s opinion of cost totals \$8,807,710. We are also applying for CIB funding to supplement City funds for the project, in the form of a 50/50 grant-loan award. In any case, project costs not covered by CIB funds will be bonded for or provided from general funds.
