

**MOAB CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
SPECIAL EMERGENCY MEETING  
June 10, 2022**

Moab City Council held a Special Emergency Meeting on the above date. The meeting was conducted via electronic means with Council Chambers serving as an anchor location. Mayor Joette Langianese called the Special Emergency Meeting to order at 2:02 p.m. Councilmembers Tawny Knuteson-Boyd, Jason Taylor and Luke Wojciechowski attended. Councilmembers Kalen Jones and Rani Derasary were not in attendance. Staff participating included City Manager Carly Castle, Finance Director and Acting Deputy Manager Ben Billingsley and City Attorney Nathan Bracken. Becky Wells and Pete Byrd were present to discuss the first agenda item.

***Preservation Strip Dedication—Approved***

***Presentation and Discussion:*** Mayor Langianese explained the need for emergency action to extend a 2010 protection strip in the Byrd’s Preserve subdivision. She explained that, while protection strips are no longer recognized by City Code, the subject protection strip was grandfathered. She explained the purpose was to protect road and utility access for adjacent property owners as well as to protect the road and utility investment of the original developer.

***Motion and Vote:*** Councilmember Knuteson-Boyd moved to approve a 90-day extension to the preservation strip dedication in the Preserve Subdivision between the parties of Moab City and Dennis and Patricia Byrd. Councilmember Taylor seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0 with Councilmembers Taylor, Knuteson-Boyd and Wojciechowski voting aye.

***Executive (Closed) Session:***

Mayor Langianese determined an Executive Session would not be convened.

***Adjournment:*** Mayor Langianese adjourned the meeting at 2:10 p.m.
