Snow Removal Tips:

HELP US KEEP SIDEWALKS AND GUTTERS FREE OF SNOW AND ICE.

After snowstorms, the City's Public Works Department crews need help from residents and businesses who are clearing snow from their sidewalks, driveways and parking lots.

The owners or occupants of businesses and residences that abut paved sidewalks are responsible for removing snow and ice from the sidewalk.

City streets are a major part of our storm water drainage system so we want to keep the streets and gutters free from ice and snow that can obstruct the flow of snowmelt.

Here are some things we can all do to help us keep sidewalks and streets open and safe after snowstorms this winter:

- **When using on-street parking**, stay a few feet back from the curb. This allows the water, slush and ice to break up and flow through the drainage system.
- **When shoveling sidewalks, driveways and parking lots, etc.**, pile the snow on your property in an area where it will not build ice dams in the gutters. Residents and businesses are responsible for removing snow from the City Rights of Way adjacent to their property within 24 hours.
- **If there is no other place to pile the snow**, locate it 2 to 3 feet away from the gutter in the parking lane and pile it so that it does not obstruct the gutters or the view for vehicles using the roadway.
- **When plowing parking lots**, locate snow in areas that are close to, but not directly on top of, underground drainage systems.
- **Be safe.** Watch for snowplows and avoid driving or parking in their path.
